



Important Reminder: The annual meeting of the AGCCA will be held on Monday, December 8, 2014 at the Antioch Township Office at 8pm. We encourage and welcome all homeowners to attend.

We're halfway through Fall and, with Winter fast approaching, here's a reminder about several important community rules:

1. Parking on our roadways is prohibited between the hours of midnight and 8:00am. To facilitate snow removal from the streets, no parking shall be permitted on any street whenever there is a snowfall of two (2) inches or more. This restriction remains in effect until the snow is removed.

In addition, when clearing snow from your own driveway, please do not move the snow into the street. Several times last year, our snow plowing service was asked to return to the community to remove snow that had been left in the street after a driveway had been cleared. This costs the community additional money and, going forward, will be passed on to the homeowner who is responsible.

2. If you live near a sewer drain, please take a moment to remove any debris that may have collected and is now preventing proper water drainage.
3. Pet owners are responsible for preventing their pets from creating a disturbance or nuisance to other residents. Owners are also responsible for immediately cleaning up after their pets. And, all animals must be leashed when outside.
