First Notice of Violation	warning – no charge
Second Notice of Violation	\$25
Third Notice of Violation	\$50
Subsequent Notices	\$100

The following comments pertain to the most-often abused rules:

Please remember that parking on our roadways is prohibited between the hours of midnight and 8:00am. When you or your guests are parking on the roadways, day or night, please avoid parking opposite autos already parked on one side of the street. Emergency equipment may need to get through to reach you!
