## Important Dates to Note:

## Be aware and call the police:

We live in one of the safest communities of the Antioch and Lake Villa communities.

The reason is due to the respectable people who live here. As report by area vibes.com:

- The overall crime rate in Antioch is 54% lower than the national average.
- For every 100,000 people, there are only 3.63 daily crimes that occur in Antioch.
- Antioch is safer than 76% of the cities in the United States.
- In Antioch you have a 1 in 76 chance of becoming a victim of any crime.

The overall crime rate in Lake Villa is 69% lower than the national average.

For every 100,000 people, there are only 2.44 daily crimes that occur in Lake Villa.

Lake Villa is safer than 81% of the cities in the United States.

In Lake Villa you have a 1 in 113 chance of becoming a victim of any crime.

However over the past 15 years I have lived here, I have heard of items stolen from cars and trucks parked outside and inside garages. A basement window on Trevino Lane was broken by someone. The latest was just last month on N. Tee Side Ct. items were taken from a car and last week on N. Long Drive a neighbor heard some kids out by their car and when confronting them, the kids took off running into the woods that are located south of the golf course.

Keep your eyes open and your car and front doors locked. Please CALL THE POLICE and let them know if you see or hear any suspicious activity. The police MUST BE MADE AWARE OF ALL suspicious activity. Nothing good can come out of kids scoping out your car, back door, porch, deck, looking for anything of value. We cannot let this activity go unreported. This activity will continue until WE MAKE IT STOP! There are people in our area looking for opportunities. LET'S NOT MAKE IT EASY FOR THEM.

## Pig Roast:


